AMO Activity

01/09/2021 to 05/12/2022

1. On 21/09/2021, a team of AMO members met the Hon'ble Union Cabinet Minister of AYUSH Ports Shipping & Waterways **Shri Sarbananda Sonowal** at Guwahati and felicitated him. Team members also apprised him of the aim and objective of AMO and seek his guidance and help to develop the Ayurvedic System of Medicine in the state.
2. Organized **Workshop on Panchagavya Chikitsa**, co-organized by Bharatiya Gau-bangsh Rakshan Samvardhan Parishad at Govt. Ayurvedic College, Guwahati on 21/10/2021 and on 22/10/2021 at Panchyajanya Bhawan, Ulubari, Guwahati.
3. Organized **9 (Nine) Virtual Clinical CME** for Ayurvedic practitioners and students on 26/10/2021, 09/11/2021, 16/11/2021, 23/11/2021, 30/11/2021, 14/12/2021, 04/01/2022, 18/01/2022, 01/02/2022 to update the clinical knowledge of the Ayurvedic physicians as well as students. The speaker was Dr. Bishnu Choudhury, NEIAH, Shillong, Dr. Abhishek Bhattacharjee, NEIAH, Shillong, Dr. Kaushalya Khaklary, Govt. Ayurvedic College, Guwahati, Dr. Jitendra kumar N Varsakiya, CBPACS, New Delhi, Dr. Rajaram Mahto, All India Institute of Ayurveda, New Delhi, Dr. Anup Baishya, Govt. Ayurvedic College, Guwahati, Dr. Amit Chavan, Pune, Dr. Hemen Kalita, Govt. Ayurvedic College, Guwahati and Dr. Anuradha Roy, Faculty of Ayurveda, BHU, Varanasi.
4. Ayurvedic Medical Organization (AMO), Assam celebrated **6th Ayurveda Day and Dhanwatari Jayanti** on 2nd Nov 2021 in **30 different places of Assam** (covered 28 districts). On this occasion, free health check-ups and awareness camps were organized and free Ayurvedic medicines were distributed among the patients. **Shri Diganta Kalita, MLA**, Kamalpur in Kamrup, **Shri Ganesh Kumar Limbu, MLA** in Barchalla (Sonitpur), **Shri Prasanta Phukan, MLA** in Dibrugarh, **Shri Bidya Singh Enleng, MLA** in Diphuhas inaugurated the event in their area and endorsed to adopt Ayurvedic System of Medicines for prevention and treatment of their ailments. They also mentioned that the demand for ancient and Vedic Indian Systems of Medicine is increasing day-by-day worldwide due to their better efficacy, and tolerability in treating different lifestyle diseases, chronic diseases, Gynecological disorders, joint and neurological diseases, abdominal and skin diseases, etc. **Professor Nani Gopal Mahanta**, Advisor to Chief Minister of Assam, **Dr. Umesh Chakraborty**, Assam Khetra Sanghachalak, **Dr. Bhupesh Dev Sarma**, Uttar Assam Prant Sanghachalak, **Shri Surender Talkedkar**, Organizing Secretary, Seva Bharati Purbanchal, also attended the events. In the program Joint director of health services, Additional Deputy Commissions (Health), District RSS office bearers, media personnel, social workers, and distinguished personalities were present in their respective localities. A huge number of the public benefited across the state from the free health check-up and awareness camps. This is the first time happened in Assam that Ayurveda Day and Dhanwatari Jayanti were celebrated all over Assam in benefitting manner. **A total of 4055 patients benefited.**

6. On 05/11/2021 a team of AMO members met Shri Keshab Mahanta, Hon'ble Health Minister of Assam, and Dr. Lakshmanan S, IAS, Director Ayush cum Mission Director NHM, Assam discussed the objectives and activities of AMO. Subsequently discussed the issues related to vacancy filling, new Ayurvedic colleges & Hospitals, enhancement of superannuation age (65 Years), promotion, service rules for both Ayurvedic College & Medical Officers (Ayur) along with PG seat issue of our students. All the problems were discussed vividly and sorted out solutions for early implementation. They assured to provided quality Ayurvedic medicines will be shortly in every district. Also requested to start functioning district Panchkarma centers and inclusion of the basic concept of Ayurveda & Yoga in Secondary School curriculum. Requested to start Panchakarma therapist, Ksharasutra technician, and Ayurvedic Pharmacist course under skill development mission at Govt. Ayurvedic College, Assam.

7. A Free Health check-up camp was organized at Diphu, Karbi Anglongon 30/11/2021 in collaboration with Akhil Bharatiya Vidyarthi Parishad (ABVP), Diphu, Assam. 75 patients were examined and distributed free Ayurvedic medicines.

8. Organized a Free Health camp and Pain Specialty camp on 12/12/2021 at Kendukona (Baihata) Kamrup. More than 70 patients were examined and free Ayurvedic medicines were distributed.

9. Organized a 2-days workshop on **Marma Chikitsa** on 28/12/2021 and 29/12/ 2021 in collaboration with National Ayurveda Students and Youth action (NASYA) and Ayurvedic Medical Organization (AMO) **at Govt. Ayurvedic College, Guwahati.**

10. On 27th February 2022 a Free Ayurvedic Health Awareness cum Check-up Camp is organized by Ayurvedic Medical Organization (AMO), Assam and Shri Bajrang Ayurved Bhawan, Guwahati in association with Pub-Madhab Deb Nagar Unnayan Samiti at Devkota Nagar, Maligaon, Guwahati. 105 patients were checked and distributed free Ayurvedic Medicines. Blood Sugar Check also checked all needy patients in the camp.

11. On 8th March 2022 on the occasion of **International Women's Day**, we organized **6 (Six)** no's of free **Health Check-Ups & Awareness** camp, especially for women, i.e. in Dibrugarh, Cachar, Baska, Dhubri, Diphu, and Nalbari districts of Assam. **Dr. Umesh Chakraborty**, Assam Khetra Sanghachalak, attended the events at Nalbari. In the program District RSS office bearers, media personnel, social workers, and distinguished personalities were present in their respective localities. A huge number of the public benefited from the free health check-up camps. **A total of 775 patients benefited.** Free Ayurvedic medicines were distributed among the patients.

12. For awareness regarding women's health-related issues, we have organized a **Seminar** on the occasion of **International Women's Day on 8th March 2022 at Govt. Ayurvedic College, Jalukbari, Guwahati**. **Hon'ble Member of the Lok Sabha, Guwahati Smt. Queen Oja Madam** was present as Chief Guest on that program. 14. Under the guidance of Assam Kshetra Pracharak Mananiya Shri Ullhas Kulkarni Ji on 30/11/2021, 01/4/2022 & 23/08/2022 a team of AMO members, met Shri Jayanta Malla Baruah, Hon'ble MLA cum Political Secretary of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam. He appreciated the efforts of AMO in organizing free health check-ups and awareness camps for public benefit. On **22/08/2022**, we felicitated him for being inducted as a cabinet minister and requested to fill the existing vacancies, enhance of superannuation age (65 Years), age relaxation in the recruitment of Medical officers (Ayur) for those who are working under NHM. Requested to start Panchakarma therapist, Ksharasutra technician, and Ayurvedic Pharmacist course under skill development mission at Govt. Ayurvedic College, Assam. He assured that, will take up all the matters with Hon'ble CM.

15. On 21/06/2022, AMO celebrated the **8th International Yoga Day** in collaboration with Kamrup District Health Dept at Amingaon. Hon'ble Cabinet Minister of Assam Shri Chandra Mohan Patowari attended the program as a Chief Guest. AMO members also participated in Yoga demonstrations and Yoga competitions organized by various organizations in the state.

16. On 26/06/ 2022, a mega health camp was organized by the Ayurvedic Medical Organization, with the help and presence of Local MLA Sri Bhabesh Kalita, Rangia at Borkukuriya LP School, Gopalpur Village, Rangia, Kamrup to aid the **flood-affected** people. **445 patients** were treated and free medicines were distributed.

17. On 3/07/2022 a Free **flood relief** health camp was organized at Bezera, Kamrup, Assam. In the health camp, 20 doctors are provided services, and medicines are distributed free of cost to **430 patients**. Sputum sample, Malaria slide, Diabetes, etc. routine examination is done.

18. A Mega Health check-up camp (Post Flood relief camp) was organized at Changsari, Kamrup on 28 July 2022. **470 patients** were examined by specialist doctors and distributed free medicines. The camp was graced by Shri Hemanta Choudhury, OSD to Hon'ble CM and his PA Shri Pranjit Deka, and Joint Director of Health Services, Kamrup Assam.

19. On 25/08/22 a Free Health Check-up, and Swarnaprashan camp was organized at Ujjwala Shelter home, Silchar (Cachar District, Assam) in collaboration with Dabur India Limited. Also distributed health supplements and sweets to the children. A total of **30 nos of children** benefited.

20. On 07/08/2022 a free health camp was organized at Lahkarpara, Baharghat in the Nalbari district where **204 patients** were screened and Ayurvedic medicines were provided. The blood sugar and testing of the patients are also done free of cost in the said camp.

21. On 27/08/2022, Seva Bharati Purbanchal organized a free medical health camp in collaboration with the **Ayurvedic Medical Organization (AMO)**, National medico organization (NMO) & Bharat Bikash Parisad in a remote area of village Challakathar, Hidip, Karbi Anglong district, Assam. 100 patient were examined and distributed free medicines.

22. On 27/08/2022, a Free health awareness and Medical camp was organized on the premises of Balitara High School in Nalbari district under the aegis of Sukleshwar Medhi Memorial Trust and **Ayurvedic Medical Association (AMO)**. 600 patients were screened at the camp and given medicines free of cost, along with a free blood sugar test, and COVID vaccination. The camp was attended by the Joint Director of Health, Nalbari District, Dr. Bhupesh Dev Sarma, Sanghchalak, Uttar Assam Prant.

23. On **23rd October 2022**, under the aegis of the Ayurvedic Medical Organization (AMO) Assam Trust, free health camps, and awareness programs/ CMEs were organized in **25 districts** of Assam on the occasion of **Dhanwantari Jayanti and 7th National Ayurveda Day**. This year's theme of Ayurveda Day is "Har Ghar, Har Din Ayurveda". A total of **3150** patients benefited.

Shri Bhabesh Kalita, MLA from Rangia constituency and President of Assam State Bharatiya Janata Party, was the chief guest at the awareness program held at the Kamrup District DC office, Amingaon. Moreover, Hon'ble Cabinet Minister Shri Ranjit Kumar Das participated in the medical camp organized at Pathsala, Barpeta District and Shri Bidya Singh Engleng, MLA from the Diphu constituency participated in the medical camp organized at Manja in Karbi Anglong district. The Chief Executive Member of Rabha Hasong, Hon'ble Mr. Takeshwar Rabha was present at Dudhnai in Goalpara district and requested to set up more Ayurvedic medical camps in The Rabha Hasong area in the coming days, he said that he would extend full cooperation. Hon'ble Assam Kshetra Sanghachalak Dr. Umesh Chakraborty, Uttar Assam Prant Sanghachalak Dr. Bhupesh Deb Sharma along with Hon'ble Cabinet Minister Shri Jayanta Malla Baruah and Hon'ble MP, Mangaldoi Lok Sabha constituency Shri Dilip Saikia were also present in Nalbari district.

24. On 7th November, AMO organized a health awareness program through Ayurvedic medicine and the Scope of Ayurveda at Demow Adarsha Jatiya Vidyalaya, Sibasagar.

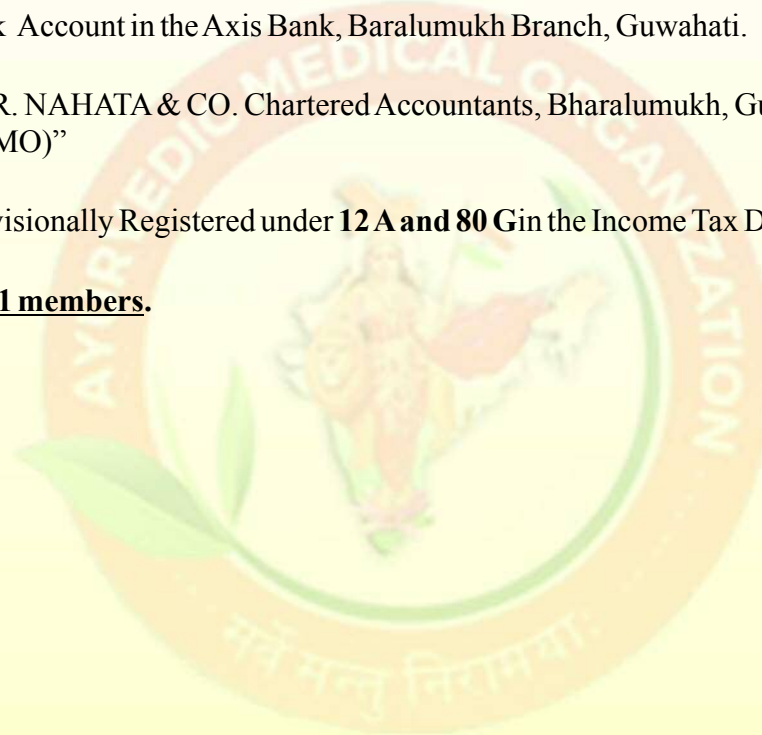
